Leukocytes (White Blood Cells – WBC)

Function – defense against diseases. They form a mobile army that helps protect the body from damage by bacteria, viruses, parasites, toxins, and tumor cells.

<u>PHIL</u> eats grains (neutrophils, eosinophils, basophils) – have granules (grains) containing cytokines, destructive enzymes, toxins, and signaling molecules.

No grains in sight (cyte) – monocytes, lymphocytes.
